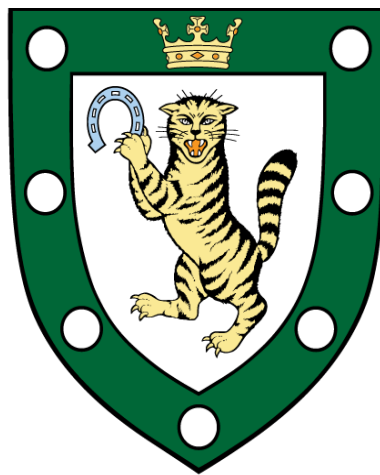

**BURGHFIELD 3 MAN TEAM TOURNAMENT
FOR THE DR JOHN MACLEOD MEMORIAL CUP**

SATURDAY 29 APRIL 2017

1. The competition will consist of one round of Stroke Play over the Championship course and will be open to members of all recognised Golf Clubs aged 16 and over (boys under 16, holding a Category 1 Handicap will be eligible), who are amateur golfers as defined by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews.
2. Entry shall be as a team of three. At least one member of the team shall have a handicap of 12 or less, and at least one member a handicap of 13 to 24. **Inactive handicaps will not be accepted. Handicap certificates are required and must be produced at registration on the day of the competition, this requirement is not applicable to competitors whose Home Club is Royal Dornoch.**

Competitors, who, after entry find that their handicap no longer meets the competition requirements, will not be eligible to play and should notify the Club as soon as possible at which time a full refund will be given.

Any golfer who does not turn up for his appointed tee time without good reason and/or fails to inform the Club will not be eligible to compete in this event for three years.

3. For the team competition the best TWO nett scores will count, the third will count only in the event of a tie.
4. ENTRY WILL BE LIMITED TO 54 TEAMS.

All entries received by 9.00am on Monday 13 February 2017 will be entered into a ballot for places. 2016 defending champions entering with at least two members of the winning team will be guaranteed entry if received by the ballot date.

The result of the ballot will be notified to entrants by Thursday 16 February 2017. Unsuccessful entrants will be placed on the waiting list.

5. ENTRY FEES:

MEMBER	£ 17 per person
STRUIE MEMBER	£ 34 per person
NON-MEMBER	£ 50 per person

ENTRY FEES ARE PAYABLE WHEN ATTACHED ENTRY FORM IS SUBMITTED.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEE.

NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE DRAW IS MADE.

6. The draw will be published on 14 April 2017.
7. The competition is under the control of the Council of Management of the Royal Dornoch Golf Club, Golf Road, Dornoch, Sutherland, whose decision on all matters will be final.
8. The Prize Giving will be held in the Clubhouse as soon as possible after the conclusion of the Competition.
9. PREFERRED STARTING TIMES: The Club will make every effort to meet the wishes of competitors, but no guarantee can be given. It will be appreciated if preferences are expressed in broad terms (e.g. 'before 9am', '10am to 12.30pm', 'afternoon'), rather than in requests for specific times.
10. **Catering will start with breakfast rolls from 9am** and will continue all day with a menu specifically designed for the weekend available until late. No reservations will be taken.
11. Royal Dornoch Golf Club is fully committed to alleviating the problem of slow play. Our open competitions will have on course marshals and penalties applied to the culprits. As a condition of entry you are accepting the responsibility to keep a good pace of play as advertised at the time of the event and to complying with all the competition rules.
