TERMS OF COMPETITION:

- The competition will consist of one round on the Championship Course or *9 holes on the Struie Course and is open to Juniors who are under 18 years of age on 1 January 2020.
- Entry to the event on the Championship Course is limited to 90 entrants who are required to hold a handicap of 28 or less for boys and 36 or less for girls. For those who do not meet the entry requirements for the event on the Championship course then they may enter the 9 Hole event on the Struie course. In the event of entries exceeding the limit of 90, the Council of Management reserve the right to split the entrants by handicap and play an additional event on the Struie Course with a reduced entry fee and separate prizes
- Boys from yellow tees, girls from red tees. Struie Competition from red tees
- No Caddies
- **Current handicap certificates for Championship Course competitors must be produced at registration on the day.** Entrants will play at current handicap
- Any Competitor who does not turn up for their appointed tee time without good reason and/or fails to inform the Club will not be eligible to compete in this event for three years.
- Entry Fee £10pp for Championship Course and £6pp for Struie Course to be **paid at registration on the day.**
- **Closing date for entries 12 noon on Wednesday 8 April. For all competitors who enter before Wednesday 1 April, they will receive a special gift.**
- Royal Dornoch Golf Club is fully committed to alleviating the problem of slow play and promotes the R&A initiative of *Ready Golf* in all our strokeplay events. For those unfamiliar with the term *Ready Golf* we would encourage all competitors to familiarise themselves with the guidelines as advertised on our competition noticeboard prior to play.
