

## **Royal Dornoch golf facilities and arrangements from Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020**

The following notes are specific to Royal Dornoch and are in addition the Covid-19 legislation and guidelines as set out by the Scottish Government. There will be sanitation units at each entry and exit point of the clubhouse and these must be used. Please be considerate to your fellow golfers, take all necessary precautions and notify the General Manager if there are any areas of concern.

**While we are doing our best to put in place all the necessary systems to ensure a safe environment we expect everyone who uses our facilities to be aware of ours, and the Scottish Government guidance and legislation, and to self police to ensure compliance.**

- **Pro Shop**

- Maximum of 4 customers at any one time
- Only the front shop door will be open.
- Please observe social distancing guidelines if queueing to enter the shop.
- The wearing of masks is mandatory (please bring your own).
- Loyalty/Credit Card or Pro Shop Account payments only.
- **No cash transactions.**

- **Clubhouse**

- Entry only for those that have a booking for or wish to partake of food and drink or require to use the toilet facilities.
- Masks must be worn in the clubhouse
- There is a strict one way system
- Entry will be via the front door only, exit via side door only. Please follow the signage.
- Locker rooms will remain closed.
- Toilet facilities will be provided upstairs. Disabled toilet available by request.

- **Club Office**

- Entry is for staff only and is closed to members and visitors.
- Please make contact by phone or email only.
- Members to book online whenever possible. All details of the participants will be taken on the day of play to satisfy 'Track & Trace'.

- **Food & Beverage**

- Is open with limited services. See further details below.
- To ensure good ventilation windows may be opened.
- The HWH will open on certain days, opening times available on the day

### **Additional Facility Rules and Usage Guidelines:**

- **Food & Beverage**

- Opening times (see below).
- You may remove your mask while seated but your mask must be in place if you get up from your seat at any time
- For Track & Trace you must put your name, time of arrival and contact telephone number on the sheet provided at the entry door.

- It will be table service for both food and drink. Once allocated your table you will be allocated a dedicated server.
- **The legislation on the number of households that can meet at a time is as follows: 6 people from up to 2 households indoors and outdoors.**
- You are not permitted to move tables or rearrange the seating/table layout.
- You may only have a table for 1½ hrs, after which time you may be asked to leave.
- There will be a reduced food menu (see below).
- Prebooking of tables for both food and/or drink is highly recommended to ensure that you are accommodated and to help the staff provide the best level of service.
- Bookings can only be made by telephone in advance between 10am-5pm. Please call 01862 810219 ext. 4.
- Walk-ins will be accepted if a table is available at the time of your arrival.
- Weather permitting these facilities will also be available outside.
- Take away from the menu will also be available.
- Credit Card and Loyalty card account payments only. Loyalty cards have to be produced to benefit from your member discount.
- **No cash transactions.**

- **Golf Facilities**

- All play must be in accordance with the 'Rules of Safe Golf' previously circulated and attached.
- Rental equipment, including buggies will be available and sanitised prior to play
- All rentals (excluding push trollies) must be pre-booked prior to play.
- Caddies may be requested via the Club office prior to play, please see attached conditions
- The toilets at the HWH will only be open when the HWH is open.

- **Competitive Golf**

- Competitions as per the fixture list.
- All competitions should be entered by emailing [proshop@royaldornoch.com](mailto:proshop@royaldornoch.com)
- The draw and conditions of play will be emailed prior to the event

- **Supplementary Scores**

- You must email [proshop@royaldornoch.com](mailto:proshop@royaldornoch.com) prior to play to show your intention to return a card.
- The card should be completed by the Marker, and a photo sent by email by the marker to [proshop@royaldornoch.com](mailto:proshop@royaldornoch.com) .
- The 'competitor' will have their score confirmed by email once it has been recorded into their handicap record.

## **Caddie Rules and Guidance during COVID-19**

We highly recommend that each group takes a Forecaddie so that the 5 household rule is adhered too. When this changes we will amend the rules accordingly.

Caddies will not touch of any of the golfers equipment in any circumstance.

Caddies will use a trolley with the golfer placing and securing the bag.

During play golfers to remove, clean and replace clubs; mark, clean and replace their ball; pick up tees and look after their own litter.

During play caddies will give advice, yardages, replace divots and rake bunkers

Caddies will be supplied with rakes which will have been sanitised before the round and then again when returned.

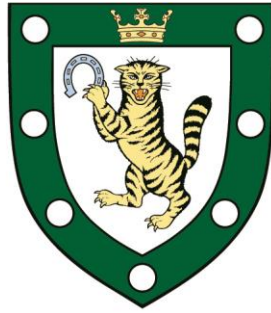
- Forecaddies will carry the rake
- Caddies taking a club trolley will have a rake attached to the trolley
- Caddies taking their own trolley will carry the rake

Caddies will not supply or carry for the golfer any consumables i.e. tees, pencils, scorecards, drinks etc.

We recommend that golfers and caddies have their own personal bottle of sanitiser

After round the caddie may take the trolley to the golfers vehicle (or the clubhouse) where the golfer will remove the bag, after which the caddie will return the trolley which will be sanitised by the pro shop staff.

For payment it will be cash only with the golfer passing this directly to the caddie. We highly recommend that both golfer and caddie sanitise their hands immediately after this and the caddie also does so with the cash.

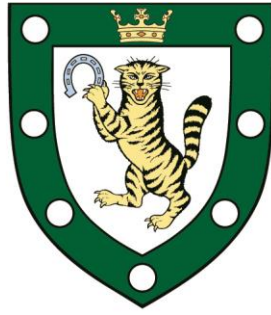
