Speed of Play

Speed of play will be monitored by our Course Ranger and players are requested to keep up with the match in front. We would be grateful if you could bear in mind that the Championship Course can provide a stiff challenge for the less experienced golfer so please use your discretion when making bookings. Our second course, the Struie, is designed to be a fair course to all abilities and provides an enjoyable experience.

Caddies

Requests should be made through the Office ahead of arrival. Due to the struggle of gathering a full complement of caddies, we cannot make guarantees but every effort is made to satisfy all requests.

Buggy Hire
