Clubhouse

Our food and beverage service operates from 10am on a daily basis. Please check our website for closing times. A wide selection of snacks and main dishes are served each day. We also have an extensive wine list and a great selection of malt whiskies. Dress Code

Smart casual. Golf caps and metal spikes are not to be worn in the Clubhouse.

Halfway House

Open on the Championship course between April – October and located at the 10th tee. Alcoholic and non-alcoholic refreshments along with sandwiches and snacks are available.

Pro Shop

Our Pro Shop carries a wide range of Royal Dornoch crested merchandise which you can buy during your visit or online.

You must check in for your round of golf and collect your hire items from the Pro Shop and we request that this is at least 30 minutes before your round.

Buggy Hire

Both courses at Royal Dornoch are traditional walking courses. Buggies are therefore only available to those who have a medical certificate and driving licence. Reserve via the Office prior to arrival at a cost of £45 per round.

Club/Trolley Hire

Pull Trolley - available on the day free of charge.

Power Trolley - prior booking necessary at a cost of £25 per round.

Club Hire - prior booking necessary at a cost of £50 per set.

Requests should be made via the Office.

Practice Facilities

The use of our practice facilities are available to everyone prior to their tee time. The Pro Shop will explain what is available when you check in. **NB - golf balls are not supplied.**

<u>Caddies</u>

Requests should be made through the Office ahead of arrival. We endeavour to fulfil all requests but do not guarantee a caddie will be available.

Caddie £60 plus discretionary gratuity
Trainee Caddie £45 plus discretionary gratuity

Fees to be paid direct to the caddie on the day. Caddies allocated but not required on the day will incur the full caddie fee.

Speed of Play / Ready Golf

We would be grateful if you could bear in mind that the Championship Course can provide a challenge for the less experienced golfer.

All players at Royal Dornoch are asked to adopt the principle of 'Ready Golf' when it is safe to do so. Speed of play will be monitored by our Course Ranger and players are requested to keep up with the match in front. Golfers not keeping pace on the course will be asked to stand aside to allow faster groups through.

Directions

Dornoch is 2 miles off the A9 just North of the Dornoch Firth Bridge. From the town square turn right, after 100 yards turn left up Golf Road to the clubhouse.
