

## **Directions**

Dornoch is 2 miles off the A9, just North of the Dornoch Firth Bridge. Drive all the way through the town and at the square, turn right. We are building a new clubhouse, so the normal carpark is closed, therefore please follow the diversion signs to the temporary car park.

It is possible to drop off passengers and golf equipment outside the clubhouse before parking your car. To do that turn left up Golf Road after exiting the Square.

Once at the clubhouse you may wait until all passengers and equipment have been dropped off, but you **MUST** then go back down Golf Road and follow the signs to the temporary car park. We hope this <u>MAP</u> is useful.

## Check In
